

## **NOTICE**

Sub: Installation and functioning of CCTV cameras in the premises of the Dental College.

It has consistently been observed that most of the Dental Colleges in the country are not complying with the directions, even after furnishing the undertaking by their Principals to the Dental Council of India, for the installation of CCTV cameras communicated vide circular letter No. DE-Website-2016/9291 dated 15<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2016, thereby directed that all the Dental College across the country are under obligation to strict comply with the decision of the Executive Committee of the Dental Council of India within 30 days for the date of issue of the letter dated 15<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2016.

Further, it has also been observed that some of the Dental Colleges, who have installed the CCTV cameras, their cameras are frequently not working or may be stopped intentionally.

Dental Council of India is extremely surprised that the college authorities either not trying to understand the content of the letter dated 15<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2016 or for the reason best known to them.

In view of the above, all the Dental Colleges who have not installed the CCTV cameras in their premises are directed to submit their compliance within seven days from the date of the issue of this notice, and those who have installed CCTV cameras make sure that their cameras are smoothly functioning and should not be stopped. Failing which the stringent action will be initiated against the defaulter college and the college authority will be responsible for consequences, if any.
